Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are all well and enjoying the warmer weather. It has been a really busy few weeks in school, with lots of great learning. We held our new Reception starters' evening for parents/carers last week and we are looking forward to welcoming the children to their first taster visits next week.

Wild Week



This week has been 'Wild Week' and the children have enjoyed taking part in outdoor activities, learning about plants, animals, habitats and the importance of looking after our natural world. Each class has taken part in a range of activities within our school grounds, in the woods and in Ferneydale. Children learned about natural dams and how they help to reduce flood risks, with George from Derbyshire Wildlife Trust. We discovered that beavers were reintroduced to Derbyshire 2 years ago. With Frances from Transition Buxton they learned about Buxton Bilberry bumblebees. They also searched for possible habitats and observed evidence of creatures and plants that used tree trunks as their habitats, and thought about long grass and hedges as habitats too.

Year 6 have been at Lea Green since Wednesday, taking part in a range of outdoor and adventurous activities. They have conquered their fears on the high ropes, built dens and toasted marshmallows in bushcraft, and also enjoyed an evening walk.
