Dear Parents/Carers,

A very happy New Year to you all! I can't believe we've already been back for 2 weeks - the new term has got off to a busy start and the weeks are flying by! Ahead of us, we have some exciting events planned to bring our curriculum to life. Reading

Children love to read at Harpur! Evidence shows that children who read for enjoyment every day achieve well in school, and also develop a broader vocabulary, increased general knowledge and a better understanding of the world and other cultures. Please make sure you continue to support your child with reading at home by:

- Hearing your child read regularly. Ideally, all children should be reading every day at home as well as at school.
- Using the local library.
- Enjoying a bedtime story.
- Talking about books and stories.
- Reading a range of fiction, non-fiction, books, magazines and web pages.
- Encouraging children to read for pleasure and read a range of books by different authors.

Winter Weather



Reception children have been enjoying their Welly Wednesdays.

This week they enjoyed a winter walk in the woods, looking for signs of winter, making snow angels and playing speckled frogs on a log. Thank you for getting your children into school this week during the winter weather. We always try to keep school open in the event of heavy snow/extreme weather, but we have to consider a number of factors in the morning: site and road conditions, staffing levels, availability of school meals etc. In the event of severe weather, we will make a decision to close (or open later) as early as possible and inform you via text message. If you are not able to send your child in due to the snow, please inform school. We appreciate that the office can be busy at these times, but please leave a message or send us an email/text if you cannot get through, as we need to know that children are safe. Occasionally it snows heavily during the day and we may need to close early. If we make this decision, we will inform you via text message. If we do decide to close early we will, of course, look after your children until you get here so please be assured that your children will be safe.

Nursery

As you may be aware, from April 2014, some children who will be 2 years old before 31st March 2024 may be eligible for 15 hours nursery provision. To see if you are eligible, please visit the Childcare Choices website:

Those most likely to be eligible will be working parents/carers. Unfortunately, eligibility for these hours does not guarantee a place at any nursery. Our school nursery is very popular and we are experiencing high demand for places. If you or anyone you know, is interested in a nursery place, please get in touch for a registration pack. We already have bookings for September 2024 and beyond. Places for 2 year olds are very limited and we encourage you to apply for a place as soon as possible.

We are holding an open evening for prospective parents/carers of 2 year olds (Bear Cubs) to come and view the nursery and meet staff on Tuesday 30th January from 3.45 – 4.15pm. Everyone is welcome, so please come along.

ATTENDANCE

Thank you for sending your children to school every day and on time. Research shows that the higher a child's attendance, the better they do in school; and this in turn improves their life chances. If a child is late 10 minutes a day, this is equivalent to missing 6 days of school in a year. We follow the national guidance for school attendance, including sharing our attendance information with the Department for Education. We continue to follow procedures from Derbyshire County Council about the issue of penalty notices for unauthorised absences. Holidays during term time will not be authorised. Leave of absence may be requested and only authorised for exceptional circumstances. We will be rewarding the children with 100% attendance, and improved attendance termly.

PUBLIC HEALTH REMINDER

Schools follow Public Health guidelines with regard to rashes, skin infections, diarrhoea, vomiting and infections. If your child is off school due to diarrhoea or vomiting it is absolutely necessary to make sure your child does not return to school until 48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting.
